BEYOND GRANTS: ONESTAR TRAINS NONPROFITS ON FUNDING ALTERNATIVES

EL PASO – OneStar Foundation, in partnership with the Nonprofit Enterprise Center of El Paso, will host a free public training workshop for senior leaders of nonprofits. This workshop, “Sustainability and Impact,” will focus on alternative funding solutions beyond grants and maximizing the effectiveness of leadership, public relations and diversifying financial resources.
