

## National Sex Offender Website (NSOPW)

- Must be Initiated <u>and</u> completed <u>before</u> start of service/work
- Screenshot with date
- Adjudicate
- All States Reporting
- Documentation of Review





#### State of Service and Residence Checks

- Must be initiated <u>before</u> start of service/work
  - Include your definition of initiation in written P&Ps
- TX DPS Public Site Check (name-based) OR TX DPS Secure Site Check (fingerprint-based)
- Must maintain documentation of initiation
  - Retain results for State Public Site Check
  - Document Initiation of Fingerprinting for Secure Site Check
- CNCS State Repositories for Out of State

## **FBI Fingerprinting Check**

- Must be initiated before start of service/work
- TX DPS Serve America Act (SAA) Account
- Must maintain documentation of initiation
  - Include your definition of initiation in written P&Ps





## Accompaniment

- Accompaniment may cease when the State
   Checks OR the FBI Checks have been completed
- A person is accompanied when he or she is <u>in the</u> <u>physical presence</u> of a person cleared for access to a vulnerable population.
- Document Accompaniment





#### **Documentation**

- OneStar's Statewide Alternate Search Protocol (ASP)
  - Approved by CNCS in December 2013 due to Texas law
  - BUT still requires programs to document:
    - The source (for example, website URL, name, address, etc.) used for the check
    - The date you initiated each check component
    - The date you received results of each component
    - Whether the person has been cleared or not for service based on the component results
    - The name and signature of the person who reviewed the results of each check component and the date on which they conducted the review.



#### NSCHC Bootcamp / Staff Checks

#### **Staff Checks**

- No different from member checks!
- Recurring Access to Vulnerable Populations versus No Recurring Access to Vulnerable Populations
- Work with and train your HR Department
- Develop written P&Ps (should be very similar to member check policies)

#### **Disallowed Costs**

- CNCS Risk-based Disallowance Matrix
  - Low, Moderate, Substantial Mitigation
  - Recurring Access or No Recurring Access to Vulnerable Populations
  - 50% of Files or Not
- \$250 \$1500 per file
- Self-Reporting = "50% off" discount
