




Total AmeriCorps Funding 2003 - 2018

Member Response

- Over 500 members provided response and recovery services
- Those members came from 20 different programs
- Nearly 1/3 of currently serving members activated







Hurricane Harvey Response

Crisis Clean-Up

- 428 members served
- 18 different program
- Nearly 5,000 hours of coverage
- Field Partners were able to respond to 80% of total requests, compared to a 55% 5-year average


